Manager's Report:

In February we held the regional sectional at Pin Palace. Our region covers Dekalb County, Northeast AL, Huntsville Association and Florence. We had 46 U12 to U18 and 3 U8 to U10. Bowlero gave each center that held a Pepsi Sectional an additional \$3000 to be divided by those that advanced to the finals. The U8 and U10 do not advance but did receive scholarship money too.

February 12-13 Youth City held at Madison Bowling Center.

Total Prize: \$972 paid in scholarships

Total money added to all local tournaments in the All Events from the money from Nationals

Open: \$218 Woman: \$56 Youth: \$92

Money left in that earmarked line is \$865 for use in future tournaments.

We hosted the Woman's State Tournament at Redstone Lanes. Our share of the brackets & Nassau was \$831.50. We sold towels they cost us \$472.50 we made \$443.00 a loss of \$29.50. We have 17 pink, 6 red and 2 blue left. We had \$281 from previous sale of towels at the State Youth and State Open. Making us have a profit of \$245.50 from all state tournaments.

Future tournament for the State is the Mixed to be held at Redstone in June of 2023. Board members will need to put on calendar. I will **not** be available to work the weekend of June 10-11 of that year.
