

HUSBC Meeting

March 6, 2011 at Pin Palace

Present:

B. Thompson motioned to dispense with the reading of the minutes and that we accept them. Seconded by F Moore, motion passed.

Financial: Asked R Swaim to break it down more by budget line items to see better how much has been spent in each line item and see how much is left over. C Potter made a motion to accept the financial report upon proper audit, seconded by F Moore. Motion passed.

Committee Reports:

Hall of Fame: The Hall of Fame is recommending 5 applicants to be inducted to the Huntsville Hall of Fame. They are Don Holt, Rodney Graves, Ray Williams, Sam Williams, Kay Binford, Betty Houston and Shirley Cromarty. They are looking at prices for the Holiday Inn Downtown for June 25th. There will be an email with all of the applicant's qualifications. The vote will be at the next meeting. Motion to accept report by M Ferris and seconded by L Keel. Motion passed.

They also said they would like to see a point system for the Hall of Fame much like the State does.

Lane Inspection:

Old Business:

Badges: L Keel apologized for the way the badges turned out. Tabled getting more until prices of others are gotten. L Bodart made motion M Ferris seconded, motion passed.

Payment for Volunteers at State Tournament will depend on amount that comes in from the tournament. L Bodart made a motion that workers get paid for local tournaments when they work, seconded by R Gillispie. The vote was 5 yes and 7 no motion fails.

Tournament Manager paid for the duties of the tournament, being there at every shift, collecting the tournament information, processing the tournament. F Moore made a motion to pay the tournament manager 10¢ a bowler in any adult tournament. M Webber seconded the motion. After much discussion a vote on the motion is called by M Ferris and seconded by C Potter. The vote was 9 yes and 5 no motion passes.

TNBA Regional ad, M Ferris made a motion that we put an ad in TNBA State South Eastern. An amendment to the motion was to spend \$150 max total on all ads for the season. F Moore seconded, motion passed.

Audit, A J Weinberg has not contacted the lady L Bodart gave him yet.

Bowler of the Decade: M Ferris made a motion to table this until we can get a criteria for this L Keel seconded, motion passed.
