Annual Meeting July 10, 2011 held at the FOE in Huntsville at 2:30 PM. Meeting was held in conjunction with the Hall of Fame Induction.

The Youth committee affirmed their elections held at their annual meeting of officers. Sonia Potter and Jonathan Roos were re-elected. They also announced that Sparkman High School is working very hard to have a high school club available for this next school year.

New Business:

Financial: H Seal Sr. made a motion to approve the financial report at the next meeting as they were forgotten at R Swaim's home also, S Potter seconded. Motion passed. All of the above will be emailed to board for them to look over.

Hall Fame/Annual meeting: H Seal Sr. stated we will go over this more once we have the financial reports in front of us. R Swaim stated that it was in the black much unlike last year.

The age for Senior Tournament was discussed S Potter made a motion to keep it at 55 and M Smith seconded. Motion passed

State Annual Meeting was held in Birmingham in July all went well.

Lane Inspection is complete in all centers. There was discussion about paying workers again but we need to know how much more it will cost for some other equipment needed. We purchased a Dial Gauge that cost over \$400 from USBC and some tape needed for lane reader. H Seal Sr. made a motion to table this until we had this information from J Ramsey at the next meeting. R Gillispie seconded this, motion passed.

New Business:

The State Board has asked that Huntsville host the Youth Tournament for 2013 instead of 2014 as it was going to be in the same city as the State Open that year. The youth committee approved and so did the HUSBC board as a whole. Motion made by M Parrish and seconded by J Ramsey. Motion passed.

J Ramsey made a motion that all HUSBC Board members must do the Registered Volunteer Program by USBC. M Ferris seconded, motion passed

Yearbook: J Mason discussed that nationals suggest your organization not spend the money to put out a yearbook anymore. The information is already on the web available to bowlers and secretaries that may need it. M Ferris made a motion that we do not print a copy this year, but to put it on a file in PDF format so that if someone wanted to print out a copy for them they could. We would also like for it to be archived so you can look back year or years later for information. Motion seconded by S Potter, motion passed.



Tournaments:

Senior: M Ferris made a motion to call the tournament Senior Open with any combination of doubles, H Seal Sr. seconded. Motion passed with 2 opposed.

Youth: Held at Plamor this year with the first 2 weekends of January being the dates.

Women: Held at Pin Palace with the last 2 weeks in January being the dates.

Everyone is going to look over the open tournament information and it would be approved at the next meeting. S Potter made a motion that we require the house holding the tournament to put out the White Oil Pattern for them as part of a contract. M Ferris seconded, motion passed. J Mason is getting a copy of the State Board contract to help us design ours.

Absentee Policy: J Mason asked that we look over the policy and its wording. After much discussion the wording will be changed to missing 3 unexcused events. M Smith made the motion and M Webber seconded. Motion passed with 1 no.

Annual National Meeting Delegates: J Mason, L Keel, C Potter, with D Millitello alternate

Annual State Delegates: M Ferris, H Seal Sr. R Gillispie, S Potter (Y), Michelle Swaim (Y) and L Bodart alternate.

President election: The President was vacated at the annual meeting a board member of 3 year plus years is qualified to run for this position. We had two nominations that were seconded. A ballot vote was made and Jan Mason was elected at President. Leaving the 1st Vice President position open for election at the next meeting, this will be voted on by the board members and person must have been on the board for 3 years at the least.

Director Positions: There are 2 positions open along with 1 youth position. The adults will be filled by President and the Youth will be filled by R Swaim Youth Chairperson. Get information to them regarding applicants.

Minutes: L Bodart made a motion to accept minutes as emailed to board, L Keel seconded. Motion passed.

Financial: L Keel made a motion to accept financial report as emailed to the board pending proper audit, J Ramsey seconded. Motion passed.

Committee Reports:

Publicity: D Millitello has updated all of the Association Boards from the 2010-2011 season.

Local Awards: L Bodart found out the prices on replacement patches is higher than expected. She will check with the company to see where the price break is and recheck her supply to see if we can get a lower price on the needed patches. L Keel made a motion to table the awards until we hear, D Millitello seconded. Motion passed.

Lane Inspection: J Ramsey researched the possibility of charging more for lane inspection. He found USBC says you can only charge \$5.00 per lane. If we have enough help we have enough equipment. Need to upgrade some of it as we go not all at once. It was tabled at the last meeting as to pay workers for their time. D Millitello made a motion to allow \$6 for breakfast or lunch for the workers and the remaining money will go towards purchase of new equipment. M Smith seconded and motion passed.

Audit: L Keel said the meeting went well and the books were all in order. L Bodart motioned to accept and R Gillispie seconded. Motion passed.

S Potter came in.

Hall of Fame/Annual Meeting: We got a lot of good comments about combining the two events. M Webber made a motion to keep the two events together as one again. P Jordan seconded motion. Vote was 8 yes and 2 no, motion passed.

S Potter had to leave.

Old Business:

Tournament Contracts: J Mason had emailed the contract the state used we went over it. M Webber suggested that she go through it and put together a contract for us to look at and email it to the board.

J Gaddis had to leave.

City Tournament Open: M Webber made a motion that we have the tournament in one house using the White Oil pattern. L keel seconded motion passed. To put each house having a tournament this year the open will be held at Madison Bowling Center. D Millitello made a motion to change the handicap to 90% of 230, M Smith seconded. Motion passed. M Webber motioned the payout be changed to 1-10 for scratch, 1-5 handicap with 20% of prize money to scratch and 80% to handicap. M Smith seconded motion passed.

AL State Youth Tournament: J Mason contacted Mobile and told them we would host the youth tournament in 2013 instead of them. We are waiting on the word from the State Board in regards to this.

There seems to be a problem with other than AMF events being found in the centers. L Bodart seconded motion passed.

Tournaments: R Swaim said she would email out the report for all of the tournaments after the meeting.

Lane Inspection: J Ramsey will make a schedule for the annual inspections to be available at the next meeting. Updated parts were purchased for the lane reader. L Keel made a motion to accept, J Ferris seconded. Motion passed.

Old Business:

J Mason asked all committee chairs to be sure they have a policy for the policy manual. If you did not get a copy of the policy manual please be sure to get one.

J Mason asked who needed Association shirts to see her to get them ordered.

Badges: It was suggested that we do an insert type of badge with a metal magnetic or lanyard for board members. This will cost less and we can use it as members of the board may change.

Bowl for the Cure: J Mason reported that this organization has many rules and regulations in order to collect money for them. She has contacted the foundation and has received no answer. She



asked if anyone was interested in checking into this further to let her know. S Potter suggested that we collect money for a local Cancer Society. J Mason will check into this as a possibility for us.

Tournament workers: J Mason has a list of who has worked the local tournaments so far this year. Those that have not will be asked to work the Senior Tournament.

A reminder was given that when the board has a closed meeting or session what is discussed in it has to stay that way until it is made public.

Senior Tournament: R Swaim went over the price given to her by Parkway Lanes for lineage on the Senior Tournament. The cost they gave was \$10 per event per person. This would raise the cost of the tournament by \$4 per person per event. J Ferris made a motion that we place the Senior Tournament on a bid from Madison, Plamor, and Redstone. L Keel seconded, motion passed. R Swaim will submit bid information to houses. There will be an email vote to decide on the house. Tournament will be bowled in May first 2 weekends.

New Business:

Plaques for Bowler of the Year for adults was asked about, R Swaim stated they were here in her car being delivered to the houses of the bowlers. They had been put in a corner as she had moved at the time they were picked up. There was much discussion as to if we were going to continue to pay these people money for this award. We had postponed last year until we had a better understanding of our financial standing. We had much discussion that membership has gone down over the last couple of years and we needed to think about this. The cost of this is \$600 a year to be taken out of the Service Program. M Smith made a motion that we no longer give money for this award only a plaque. C Potter seconded motion passed with 1 no.

M. Smith made a motion to no longer give Secretary of the Year and Director of the year money but to give them a plaque. C Potter seconded motion passed. The bowler of the year policy will be updated to reflect this information.

State Hall of Fame was available online but J Mason and R Swaim did not get additional information out. Oops and sorry. The information regarding Directors for the State Board is online if anyone is interested in applying for a position. R Swaim stated that they usually only allow 3 per area and we currently have 3 from Huntsville, R Swaim, J Mason, and L Keel. If anyone was interested in a position be sure they went online for application.

Open City Tournament: Tournament went well most bowlers were fine with it being in one house with the White Oil pattern. There were suggestions made to arrange the schedule different.

National Convention: J Mason and L Keel went to Texas for this meeting. One thing brought up in the Regional meeting was they will no longer be using magnets for awards. They are going to a ball tag; this will be replaced in the new shipment. At the voting the following took place. As of August 1, 2012 a member that purchases a card in the summer will have to purchase another card in August at the beginning of the new season. It will no longer carry over like it has in the past. The financial year for Nationals is now January 1 to December 31. It doesn't change the bowling year or season.

Boxes on boards for tournament information at Pin Palace and Parkway: L Bodart is going to try to get it in writing from the district manager that will be here next week. This is so we can get tournament information out to the bowlers in these houses.

Create a new Rule 106g.

Requires the bowler on the right lane to make the first delivery when both bowlers have completed the same number of deliveries.

Amendment No. LR 2 - Accepted (518 approve, 271 reject)

Rule 113b. Procedures

Rule 113c. Special Contests

Requires games bowled in a playoff or special contest to count toward averages.

Amendment No. LR 3 - Accepted (601 approve, 182 reject)

Rule 118b. How Established

Allows the league's board to adjust a player's average upward during the season with a two-thirds vote.

Amendment No. LR 4 - Accepted (725 approve, 58 reject)

Rule 120. Position Matches

Defaults total pins plus handicap to be used to break ties for position matches for handicap leagues.

Tournament Rules (majority needed)

Amendment No. TR 1 - Accepted (662 approve, 125 reject)

Rule 319a. Conditions that Apply

Requires bowlers to use the highest of either their composite average of all leagues, or the bowler's highest single-league average of 21 games or more.

Amendment No. TR 2 - Rejected (82 approve, 705 reject)

Rule 319c. Average Adjustment (Rerating)

Does not allow the tournament manager to request a bowler to report an average adjustment which was issued beyond the last 12 months.

Bylaws (two-thirds vote needed)

Amendment No. B 1 - Rejected (184 approve, 600 reject)

USBC National Bylaws

Article III, Membership Dues

Section B, Dues

Changes the maximum USBC adult state dues from \$1 to \$3.

Amendment No. B 2 (amended) - Rejected (466 approve, 325 reject)

USBC National Bylaws

Article IV, Board of Directors

Section E, Item 16

Caps the maximum amount the national board can set on national dues to \$15.

Note: After initial rejection, amendment was returned to a vote but was rejected (483 approve, 312 reject).

Article V, Board of Directors

Section A, Board Composition, Authority and Duties

Removes the maximum limit on State dues and allows the State Board to set dues for the association.

Article V, Board of Directors

Section A, Board Composition, Authority and Duties

Removes the maximum limit on Local dues and allows the Local Board to set dues for the association.

Amendment No. B 5 - Rejected (155 approve, 631 reject)

USBC National Bylaws

Article V, Officers

Section C, Term

Requires the USBC President's term in office to be a single, three-year term.

Amendment No. B 6 - Accepted (659 approve, 128 reject)

USBC National Bylaws

Article XI, Fiscal Year

Removes the fiscal year from the bylaws.

Amendment No. B 7 - Accepted (550 approve, 242 reject)

Merged Local USBC Bylaws

Article IV, Membership and Dues

Removes the provision that membership purchased in a summer league receives next season's membership.
