



HUSBC Board meeting held at Madison on August 5, 2012 at 2PM. We had a quorum guest was Joey Pirani.

Minutes: L Bodart made a motion to dispense with reading of the minutes. Seconded by L Keel, motion passed. M Parrish made a motion to accept the minutes of last meeting, J Ramsey seconded. Motion passed.

Financial: R Swaim furnished reports for the monthly meeting in addition to a yearend report for the season. J Ferris made a motion to accept, M Parrish seconded. Motion passed.

Committee: J Mason went over the new committee sheet.

Local Awards: L Bodart stated that she had given J Mason and R Swaim a report on her count. She asked if she was to use up what she had and then use the tag awards. The response was yes.

J Mason then opened the floor to discuss with Joey Pirani about the web. After much discussion it was decided that on the Season Page R Swaim will send a report to Joey once a month on the 650 for women and 700 for men. The Honor page will also be sent to Joey of the 298, 299, 300 and 800. This information will be furnished by R Swaim instead of through the league secretaries. D Millitello made a motion to do the above, seconded by J Courtemanche, motion passed. Pictures of the board members along with their name will be put on the web so the members will know who they are. A list will be sent to Joey with the tournament information so he can put it on the web for events in our area. R Swaim asked him about leagues that are on the web that are not sanctioned. He replied they can be removed. R Swaim is going to send him updated list of all active leagues so he can update them.

Old Business:

L Bodart talked to Jason Anders Assistant Manager at Parkway in regards to boxes for tournament entries. He did not know anything. M Parrish stated that Pin Palace is in the process of putting up boxed by the board for this purpose.

Check issue: J Mason stated that an email was sent to the board that issue had been resolved and did not concern HUSBC.

New Business:

M Smith opened up a discussion about Bowler of the Month for the Adults. He stated that there were very few applications sent during the Summer. He made a motion that for a bowler to qualify for Bowler of the Month the following would have to be met all year long. A Regular Bowler male must bowl at



least a 700 Scratch or a 725 Handicap. A Regular Bowler female must bowl at least a 600 scratch or a 625 Handicap. Seniors must bowl at least their average. J Ferris seconded, motion passed.

Bowler of the Year committee will have a submission soon.

J Mason went over the Absentee Policy as a reminder to the board. Board members must be present at all meetings unless they contact her or R Swaim in advance. Once a member has missed 3 meetings unexcused they could be removed from the board. Included in the meetings are the email votes during the season. S Bundy does not have email but will need to communicate her vote by phone or letter.

Tournaments: R Swaim went over dates of the tournaments the schedule will be as follows:

Youth – Madison Bowling Center – January 12th and 13th one weekend. Madison bowlers will bowl in the morning shift; Pin Palace will bowl in the afternoon shift. Plamor will bowl any time.

Women – Madison Bowling Center – January 19th and 20th, January 26th and 27th.

Pepsi Sectional – Pin Palace – February 2nd this is regional to include, Huntsville, Athens, Decatur, Florence, Muscle Shoals, and North East.

Open – Plamor – February 9th – 10th and 16th -17th.

Senior – November 3rd – 4th and 10th – 11th. Waiting on bids will email for vote. This tournament will now be open. Any combination will be allowed for the Team and Doubles events. Singles will be in Divisions the same as Bowler of the Month age as of August 1, 2012. Motion was made by D Millitello and seconded by M Smith, passed.

R Swaim went over the Youth State Tournament to be held here in March. It will require all Board members to work and help with this tournament. We need to pick a shirt to sell, items to be used for raffles and stuff for bags to be given at the tournament. L Keel is going to contact motels for prices. J Mason is going to contact some businesses for donations. R Swaim will provide them with a letter with the letter head on it.

Board members were handed a copy of the Association Leader Commitment forms. All read and signed the form and turned it in. This will be done every year by board members.
