Committee Reports:

Local Awards: L Bodart reported that she was running out of some of the awards. These are ones that are also covered this season by Nationals. A message will be sent to all Secretaries that if an award is given by Nationals this season we will not issue a local of the same as we run out. Currently we are out of 175 game. As we set up new program no replacements will be purchased.

Old Business:

M Ferris asked about the status of the new web site. M Webber went over the details. He and R Swaim are going to make a manual for the secretaries to use so they can get the standing sheets on the new web. It will be set up that they will place them on it instead of having someone do it. Much like bowl.com does presently. The new site will be up and ready for use by the time the current contract runs out.

J Courtemanche made a motion that we host a Hall of Fame Induction every 2 years. M Webber seconded and motion passed. Also discussed was the revamping of the Hall of Fame guide lines. The committee will work on this with the help of G Lewis, M Ferris and M Webber.

The new inductees will be notified. Tickets will be available to sell for a cost of \$20 per ticket.

Open/Women's Tournament: R Swaim had sent to the board prior to the meeting rules that she would like to get the same in both tournaments. The decision was made to do the following for both tournaments.

#4: Cash awards will be given at a 80/20 split for Team, Doubles, Singles and All Events, 80 for Handicap and 20 for Scratch.

#5: All Events will cost \$5.00

#9: Use highest book average of 21 games from bowl.com if no book average, uses current league average of 21 games. If neither, bowler uses scratch average. The ten pin rule applies.

The Open/Women combined tournament will be moved to November to begin with the 2014-2015 season. It will go for 3 weekends starting the 1st weekend of November. We will move the Senior Tournament to October also to begin in the 2014-2015 season. M Webber made a motion and it passed.

Local Awards program: R Swaim sent out a list of proposed awards for the new program. Upon discussion the following was decided. The committee will now put together items to use for awards and present to the board.

A suggested award for high scores is a plaque with the bowler paying half and the Association paying half.

A bowler can qualify for only one award on the score example bowler shoots a 250 they will receive the 250 not 200 and 250. Motion made and passed.

Bracket Money: We earned some bracket money at the tournament this year. J Ferris made a motion that we put that money away for any software we may need. Motion passed. We collected \$65 this year.
